

Continuously Monitored: Sulphur Dioxide, Total Reduced Sulphurs, Methane, Non-Methane Hydrocarbons, Wind Speed, Wind Direction, Relative Humidity, Temperature, Barometric Pressure

Intermittently Monitored: Volatile Organic Compounds







Sulphur Dioxide (ppb, 1 hr)






Total Reduced Sulphurs (ppb, 1 hr)






Methane (ppm, 1hr)







Non-Methane Hydrocarbons (ppm, 1 hr)













Station 986: Complaints & Total Hydrocarbons

Key Messages

- The frequency of elevated hydrocarbon events has come down over time
- The frequency of triggered canister events has come down over time
- The number of complaints received by government agencies has come down over time
- The process improvements and mitigation measures implemented by local industry have resulted in improvements in air quality
- Ongoing monitoring and assessment is required
- Further analysis of canister data is required
