PRAMP is celebrating Clean Air Day in the Peace River region with our first ever Clean Air Photo Challenge. Clean, healthy air is important to enjoying the abundance of outdoor activities that the beautiful Peace River Region offers.

Share photos of activities you do to keep the air clean or activities you enjoy outdoors. Share your photos on Facebook or Twitter @prampairshed. Do you ride your bike, walk or carpool? Do you shop locally, grow your own food or recycle? Do you take an evening stroll or paddle on the river? There are so many ways to contribute to and enjoy the clean air.

Rules:

1. No purchase necessary.
2. Entrants must be a permanent resident within Alberta. All winners may be required to show proof of permanent address.
3. Photos to be taken with the Peace River region north of Grande Prairie and west of Edmonton.
4. Only photos shared on @prampairshed (Facebook or Twitter) will be eligible to win.
5. Entrants are encouraged to enter as many times as they like between June 6 to July 2, 2018. Each entry must be a distinct and different photo.
6. The entrant is required to submit the location of where the photograph was taken.
7. By submitting a photo, the entrant is consenting for the photograph, their first name, and the location of the photograph to be used on PRAMP communications channels.
8. \$100 prizes will be given to two random entries. Chance of winning depends on the number of entries.
9. Winners may be required to show proof of age. If not 18 years of age or older, the prize must be accepted by the parent or guardian.
10. Winners must provide personal consent for their winning photograph, name, and general location (municipality) to be used on all or any of PRAMP communications channels, without further review or compensation.
11. Prior to receiving a prize, winners shall sign a standard release and liability waiver absolving PRAMP of all its obligations and accepting the prize as awarded as full and final satisfaction of all items owed by PRAMP.
