

While oil production has declined slightly since 2010, production controls have resulted in a dramatic decline in hydrocarbon emissions, as well as flaring and venting volumes. Looking at these elements together highlights the significant improvements in air quality in the Peace River area and in some cases, the products that were previously vented or flared, are now recovered for use in the energy production process.
