



## **Outreach and Education Summary Grade Five Science Presentations October 29, 2019**

School presentations are averaging at 45 minutes in length and include slides and a short movie relating air quality and the health of honeybees in our region.

The students engaged well with the presentations so far and are enthusiastic about sharing their ideas and questions on measuring and improving air quality.

The teachers have been supportive and enthusiastic. After the first two presentations it was obvious that there was too much material in the slide show, so it has been shortened to be both more in tune with the period length and more efficient in delivering the pertinent information. Our timing has been excellent as most of the classes are doing their science unit on weather this fall.

All presentations are supported by a worksheet that the teachers receive by email in advance and can use if they wish to have further discussions or have the students submit them to be graded. There is an opportunity to colour a honeybee going about its daily work on the reverse of the worksheet.

PRAMP promotional materials, for example temporary tattoos, nylon frisbees and AQHI fridge magnets, are passed out to students at the end of each presentation and the teachers each receive a gift of honey.

It has been a pleasure to visit these classes and have these important discussions with the students.

Some of the presentations include groups of Grade Four, Five and Six students.
