



FIVE YEAR HISTORY



## 2010 - 2016

- New air monitoring stations placed in Three Creeks and Reno
- Community members worked with industry and government representatives to address odour issues
- Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) held a proceeding on odours and emissions in the Peace River Area
- Recommendations from the AER proceeding resulted in the launch of PRAMP



## 2016

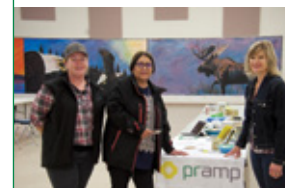
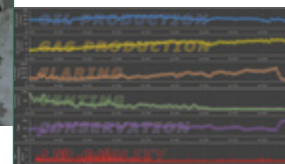
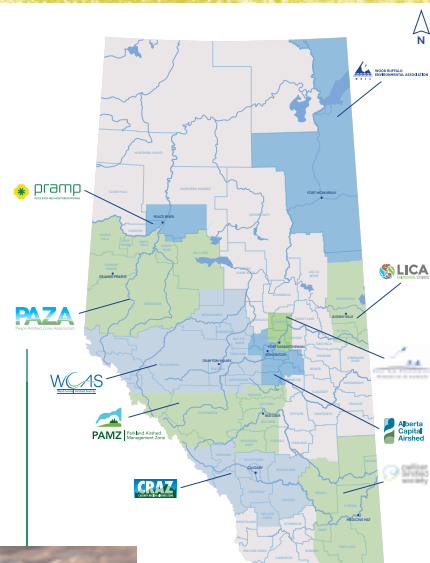
- PRAMP became a registered not-for-profit society continuing its work as a multi-stakeholder organization, working by consensus

## 2017

- Accepted as a Member of the Alberta Airsheds Council becoming Alberta's 10th Airshed organization
- PRAMP website launched with near-real time data

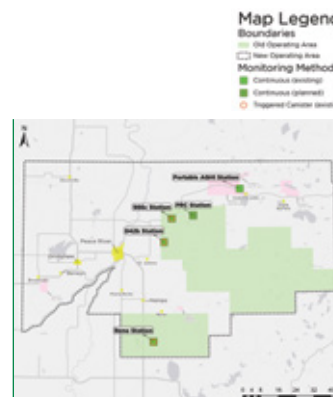
## 2018

- Partnership with Inside Education to deliver air quality programs in area schools



## 2019

- First AQHI station for the region deployed at Cadotte Lake
- Production, flaring, venting, and conservation data tracked along with air quality. Confirmed that air quality improved as a result of industry's operational changes as per AER Directive 84
- Launched the PRAMP outreach program and engaged local honey producers



## 2020

- Continuous monitoring and reporting throughout COVID-19 pandemic, while meeting all health restrictions
- Airshed boundaries expanded to include Peace River, Grimshaw, the MD of Peace and to the east of Little Buffalo

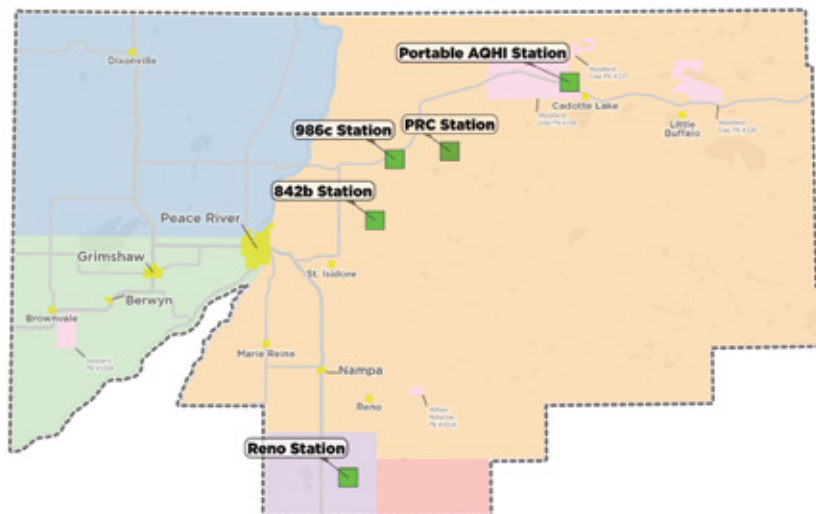


## 2021

- Capital acquisition plan to purchase (rather than rent) monitoring stations and equipment completed resulting in \$200K savings per year
- Stakeholders engaged to set new strategic direction
