- PRAMP bylaws were set by the Board in 2016 and amended in 2017

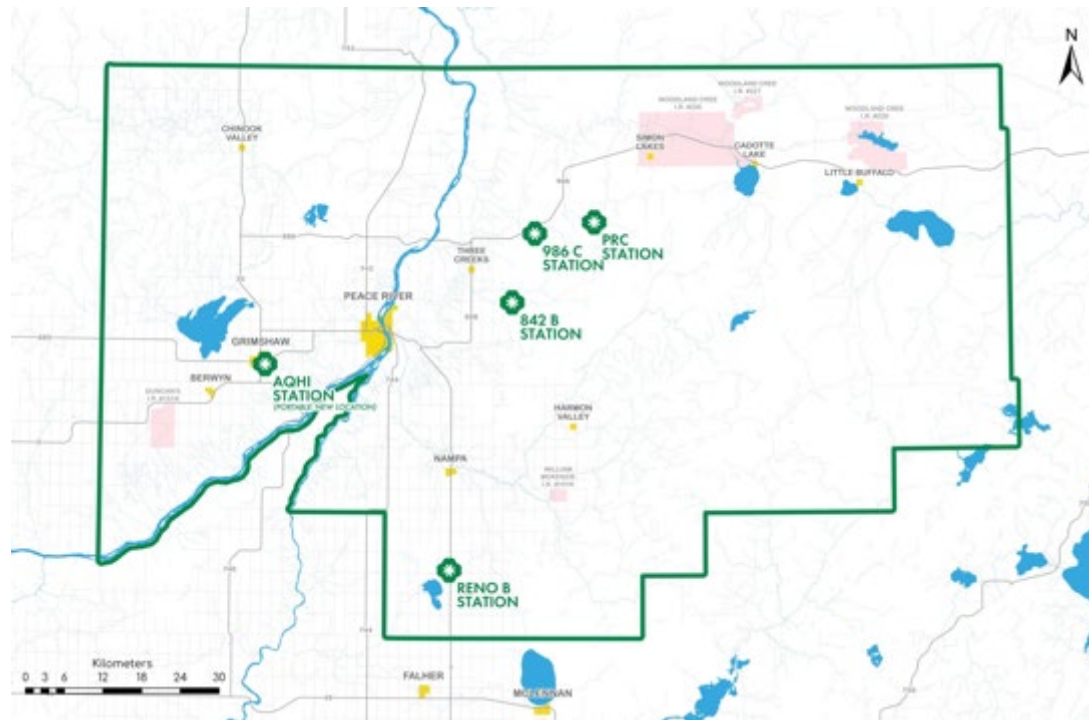


Peace River Area Monitoring Program Committee Bylaws

Boundaries

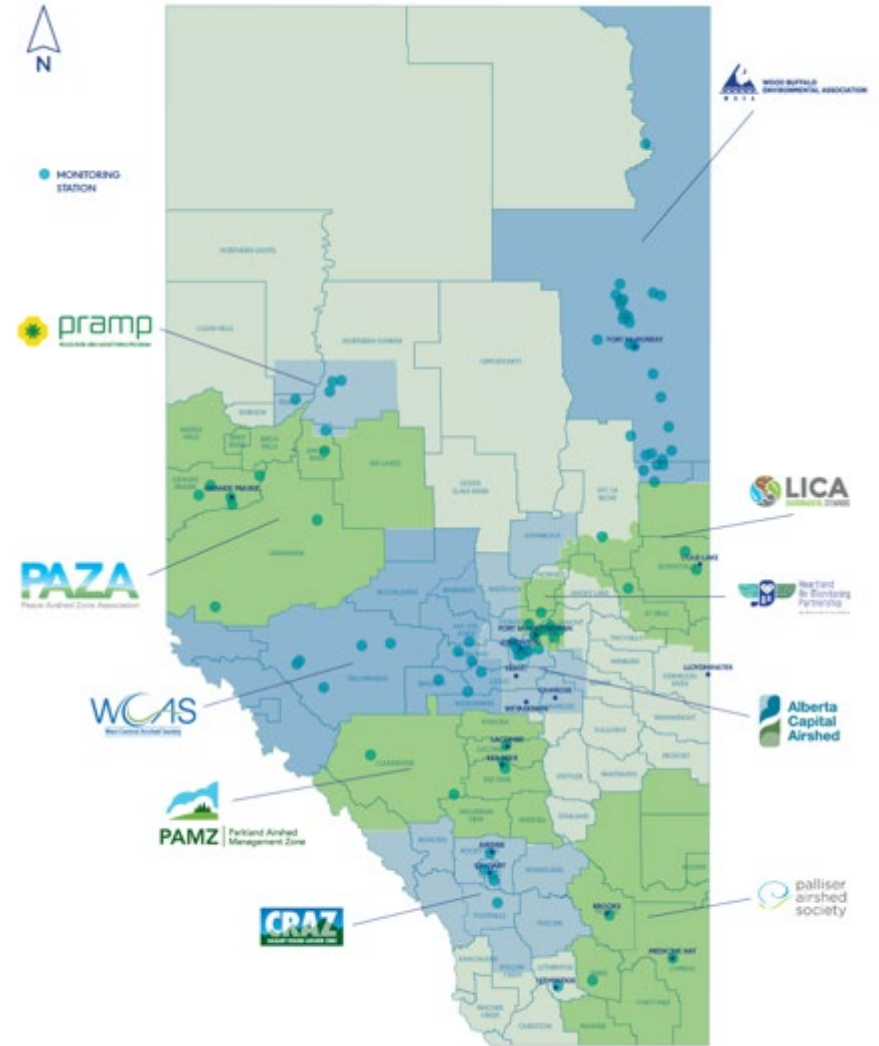


- In 2019, boundaries were expanded from Seal, Walrus, Three Creeks and Reno.
- PRAMP has recently set up PurpleAir sensors outside the current boundaries in High Level and near Fairview



Alberta Airsheds

- Airsheds adjust boundaries as needs and opportunities arise
- PRAMP could consider including:
 - Some or all of Fairview and Clear Hills Counties.
 - North and east, e.g. to Manning, High Level, Red Earth Creek



Why review boundaries?

- PRAMP can offer small sensor monitoring and outreach in additional communities
- Provide resources and information during wildfire smoke events
- Caution needed to avoid diluting resources for OSM monitoring



Possible Bylaw Updates

- Clarify Membership expiry
- Review sector representation on Board and for quorum
- Update boundaries and board meeting frequency
